Camp Eagle Rock Summer Day Camp 2009

Camp Eagle Rock, located at Friday Harbor Elementary School, is a day camp for children ages 6-12. Camp Eagle Rock (CER) is designed to provide a safe, nurturing environment that will promote self-esteem, fun, learning and the opportunity for youth to develop a variety of life-long leisure interests.

Campers may be registered by the week or for the full summer. Regular camp hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30am to 3:30pm After Camp Care is available from 3:30-5:30 pm. After Camp Care provides supervised play activities with less structure than the regular camp program.

Campers will participate in activities within their assigned group and in all-camp activities. Camp activities include music, games, sports, arts and crafts, nature and creative play. All groups make use of playgrounds, beaches, parks and other community venues within walking distance of the school. All campers will have the opportunity to swim every Tuesday at the indoor pool at San Juan Island Fitness; visit SJI Library and participate in field trips around the island using Island Rec's van and occasionally charter buses,

Campers must provide their own bag lunch. CER provides an afternoon snack.

Register using the attached Camp Eagle Rock Registration Form only. Use one Registration form per child. Camp Eagle Rock is limited to 60 kids on a weekly basis and fills quickly! Do not delay!

Registration begins May 2 at the Children's Festival. Thereafter register in person at Island Rec, 580 Guard Street Monday through Friday, 1-5pm. Completed forms along with full payment may be mailed to Island Rec at P.O. Box 1946 or dropped off in the box in front of the office.
